

Business and customer safety




Posters related to general announcements regarding business hours, premise health and general recommendations. Can be placed at the entry and common areas of the establishment.


Starting from home? Preferably use your own transport.




Wash or sanitize your hands every hour.




Wear mask.




In case you need to use public transport.




Make sure all occupants including the vehicle crew use masks.
